

**Over Fences Practice Day**  
**February 20, 2021**  
**Wilco Expo, Taylor, Texas**

**What is it?**

An opportunity to school around a show course as many as 8 times.

**How will it work?**

For a flat fee, a horse can go around an 8 fence course up to 8 times. At least two course options will be offered at each height.

**How much will it cost?**

\$125 will include a stall for the day and up to 8 trips per horse around an 8 jump hunter show course.

Shavings can be purchased for \$11 a bag, tack stalls for \$30 each,

**Rules and Regulations:**

**1. Covid 19 Rules:**

**Management** understands these rules are not always easy to adhere too. We all forget to have our masks up from time to time. Management plans to make gentle reminders to all, but if we find an individual is continually unable to comply, they will be asked to leave the show grounds. No refunds of fees will be granted to individuals who are asked to leave.

**Masks** are required at all times when not mounted. If you cannot adhere to this rule, please don't come.

**Distancing** of at least 6' when mounted and unmounted, and masked or not will be strongly encouraged. This applies even if the person you are with is a close family member. Again, if this is too difficult, don't come.

**Waivers** will be required according to facility and County rules.

**2. Helmets** are required at all times when mounted.

**3. Tack and attire:** Horses may show in non-traditional bits and equipment. Boots and polo wraps are allowed. Appropriate rider attire is required. This is a schooling event so casual riding attire is fine. Dress as if you were riding in a clinic. No T-shirts, or tank tops, please. If it's cold, warm jackets are permitted.

**4.** No numbers will be issued without a check for the office. Numbers will be required for entry into the show ring.

**5.** The number of people allowed at any one time in areas such as the warm-up area or paddock may be limited to 10.

**6.** Spectators are discouraged but if Grandfather needs to come, ask him to wear his mask and use distancing so management doesn't have to remind him.

**7.** After three (3) refusals the exhibitor will be excused and must leave the arena.

**8.** No ribbons or trophies will be awarded. Management reserves the right to give special awards if so inclined.

**9.** Management reserves the right to refuse any entries without cause.

**10.** Each horse may be ridden by multiple riders, but may not attempt the course more than 8 times.

**11.** Dogs (all pets) must be kept on a leash.

**Very Tentative Schedule – No "class" (fence height) will begin before its scheduled time.**

7:00	Barn opens for move in and ring is open for schooling
8:45	Drag
9:00-9:45	Outside lines will be cross rails, other fences 2', no oxers.
9:45	Drag
9:55-11:30	2' no oxers, outside lines will ride both directions.
11:30	Drag
11:45-12:15	2'3" with oxers
12:15	Drag, followed by a 30 minute schooling period for horses who haven't yet shown. Riders must wear the horse's #.
1:00-1:45	2'6"
1:45	Drag
1:55-2:45	2'6"-2'9"
2:45-3:30	2'9"-3' If anyone wants to jump higher we will set them after this group

**I have read the Association Rules about protective equipment; including and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Association strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.**
