3. stabling & schooling fees

Stalls must be reserved prior to the show by contacting Beverly (512)924-8562. There are a limited number of stalls, so reserving them in a timely manner is wise. 10' x 10' box stalls with doors.

Stall Fees: \$110

Shavings must be purchased at the show. You may not bring your own shavings. No horse may remain on the grounds overnight without renting a stall. Any horse schooling but not showing will be charged a \$25 schooling fee. And entry blank must be filled out for all non-showing horses.

Rules and Regulations

1. association membership requirements

Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association. All riders participating must be members of the Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association or must join at that show. All membership information (including birthdates) must be complete, or points will not be counted.

2. registration

Preregistration. Stalls may be limited. Stall reservations can be made by notifying Beverly (512-924-8562) of your stall needs. The Show Secretary, Holly Mortimer giddyupngo@att.net, must be notified of horse and rider entries by **midnight Tuesday** before the show or a \$25 late fee will be charged. Adds and scratches during the show will be allowed without penalty as usual

Numbers may be picked up ONLY if 1) an open check has been left in the office, and 2) entry blanks are COMPLETED. Any exceptions to this will need to be worked out in advance and will result in a \$50 additional office fee being added to the entry.

Class entry limit. There shall be a limit of 13 classes per horse, per day. Violation of the limit will result in loss of all points for the horse and rider(s) for the show.

Add/Scratch Policy. Adds and scratches may be made at the paddock or in the office.

Registration. Mail or email to Holly Mortimer, 3112 Mileto Dr., Round Rock, TX 78665, giddyupngo@att.net One entry blank may be used for all three shows. Entries may to emailed to Holly Mortimer at Giddyupngo@att.net or Beverly at sumcircuit@aol.com. Look for an entry blank you can fill out at beverlymanroe.com.

Office/Medic/Security fee. A \$35 fee will be charged for each rider entered at the show.

Faithful Exhibitor Discount. Rider/horse combinations showing in all 3 shows will receive a \$20 credit on their entries at the Summer Circuit Championship Show.

Trainer Stall Incentive: Trainers with 8 or more horses renting a stall at any one of the three shows will receive one stall at that show for no charge.

3. judges' decisions are final

Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or any show officials on the part of owner, manager, trainer, coach, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. This includes failure to keeps dogs on a leash or otherwise confined.

4. centex members' views

CenTex members are encouraged to discuss their views with the Ring Committee.

5. awards

Centex designated classes (CT) are recognized by the Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association. Riders must be CenTex members to compete at this show. CenTex points will be awarded to all horses and riders in these classes.

Circuit Award Points will be awarded in classes in all 3 circuit shows. No special membership or registration is necessary to be eligible.

Champion and Reserve Awards. All Hunter and Jumper division titles shall be awarded in accordance with current USEF rules.

Ties in Jumper Classes. Jumpoffs for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by the fastest time in the first round among those with equal faults. Ties for Champion or Reserve will remain tied. **Prizes.** A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise designated. Prize money will be mailed to exhibitors within three weeks after the show or credited when settling account.

ADD BACKS will be awarded as follows: 1-30%, 2-22%, 3-16%, 4-14%, 5-10%, 6-8%

PRIZE MONEY will be awarded as follows:

\$350 1-\$85 2-\$70 3-\$55 4-\$45 5-\$35 6-\$25 7-\$20 8-\$15

T.I.P. Awards. At each Summer Circuit show Thoroughbreds with a T.I.P. number from The Jockey Club (tictip.com) will be eligible for a high point award in the following categories.

Hunter High Point Thoroughbred - High (2'6" and above)

Hunter High Point Thoroughbred - Low (below 2'6")

Jumper High Point Thoroughbred - High (1.0m and above)

Jumper High Point Thoroughbred - Low (below 1.0m)

Circuit High Point Awards. Quarter sheets will be awarded at the Summer Circuit Championship Show, August 9-11, to horses and/or riders accumulating the highest number of points in the following divisions. Points will be awarded: 1st7; 2nd5; 3rd4; 4th3; 5th2; 6th1. **No championship points will count toward circuit high point awards.** Division must fill at 2 of the 3 shows to receive an award.

6. rider's attire

Riders must be properly attired, and riders will be eliminated if not properly attired. Riding coats are not required. Certified hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted. A polo shirt with collar may be substituted for a riding shirt; however, T-SHIRTS ARE UNACCEPTABLE

7. rider and trainer conflicts

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep track of the progress of classes during the show day.

While management will do its best to help exhibitors with timely announcements, it is still the exhibitor's responsibility. Rider/Trianer conflicts due to riding more than one horse in a division should be worked out with the paddock master prior to the start of the division involved. Management reserves the right to close classes before all entries have ridden if it deems it necessary in order to run the show in a timely manner.

8. veterinarian and farrier availability

A veterinarian and a farrier will be **on call**. Their phone numbers will be posted near the show office.

9. coagins test

In accordance with the requirements of the State of Texas, proof of a current (1 year) test must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be picked up.

10. refusal to keep dogs on leash or otherwise confined will be considered an act of discourtesy, and the owner shall forfeit entry and any other fees

11. texas farm animal liability act

modified children's/adult: Restricted to nonprofessional junior and adult riders. **Riders** in this division may not compete at the same show in divisions with fence heights of 3'0" or higher.

beginner rider: Restricted to non-professional riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any equitation classes on the flat or over fences prior to the first show of the current show year and have never shown over 3' or above. No cross entries will be allowed in any division with fence heights exceeding 2'6".

special beginner: Riders not to cross-enter into any other classes at this show except Spec. Beg. Rider Hunter. Horses may compete more than once as separate entries with different riders.

youth/nonpro. Restricted to non-professional and junior riders on horses or ponies.

Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders. To be ridden over a course of at least 8 fences 3' in height with two changes of direction and two stride in-and-out. Work-off optional.

95 CenTex 2'6" Medal Class

Open to non-professional riders not showing in classes with fence heights of 3' or higher at this competition. Riders must enter at least one other class at this show to be eligible. USEF tests 1–6 (Article 2213) may be used. Work-off optional.

96 CenTex Pony Medal

Fences: small-2', medium-2'3", large-2'6". Open to junior riders on ponies. Cannot cross enter into Centex Medal or Centex 2'6" Medal. Work-off optional.

A one round Handy class open to horses who have completed at least 1 course in a hunter class at this show.

Judged on performance, manners and soundness. Horses will perform over a handy 2'6" course with 2'9" options or a 2'9' course with 3' options. Horse/rider combinations showing over the higher course may not cross enter into CT Modified Hunter, CT Modified Equitation or the 2"6" Medal at this show. One point for each higher option fence jumped will be added to the horse's score. Horses may also receive bonus "handy" points.

Central Texas Summer Show only—entry fee: \$30.00 Trophy and 8 ribbons

99 **\$350 Still Point Farm Jumper Classic** (fences 2'6"-3'3") Table II, Sec.2.(a/b) Open to all horses that have competed in at least one jumper class at this show. **Decker Lake Show only**—entry fee: \$30.00 **Trophy and 8 ribbons.**

100 \$350 Summer Circuit Championship Classic.

Open to horses and ponies who have been champion or reserve champion in any hunter division at the 2024 Summer Circuit Shows. This includes divisions completed before the start of the classic at the Summer Circuit Championship Show. Fences shall be set at the heights for the division in which the horse won its award. The horse's rider must be eligible to compete in the division in which the award was won, i.e. the Adult Hunter Champion must be ridden by an eligible Adult. The class will be one round of 8 to 12 fences.

Summer Circuit Championship Show only—no entry fee Trophy and 8 ribbons

201 2' Dover Handy Spectacular Fences 2' with two oxer options.

Open to all. A one round Handy classic, one poing for each oxer option fence jumped will be added to the horse's score. Bonus points may be added for handiness.
